Each rider will be allowed 30 minutes. They will start by being coached on how to do a proper warm up before their test, based on their respective level of competition. They will then change arenas and perform the dressage test of their choice while being judged by USDF L Graduates. Auditors are encouraged to judge the tests as well. After their test is complete, the performance will be discussed by all, and some movements may be repeated with coaching for improvements.
