IF HORSES COULD SPEAK

How Incorrect "Modern" Riding Negatively Affects Horses' Health

This DVD is based on the best-selling book *Tug of War: "Modern" versus Classical Dressage*. Dr. Heuschmann presents an intelligent and thought provoking exploration of both classical and "modern" training methods, against a backdrop of the horse's basic anatomy and physiology.
