Gary has been a USEF judge for more than 25 yrs, and is 1 of only 4 International “O” Dressage Judges in the U.S. As an FEI judge, he has officiated at Pan American Games, CHIO Aachen, FEI World Cup Finals, FEI European Championships, and the 2008 Beijing Olympics. As a dressage rider, Gary was a member of the USET, representing the U.S. in competitions throughout Europe. He and his mare “Suna” won a Team Silver Medal at CHIO Rotterdam in 1993 and a Team Bronze at the 1994 FEI World Championships at The Hague, Netherlands.
