With a nod to this being an Olympic year, this year's seminar will feature the progression from Second Level to Third, the final step to earn the USDF Bronze Medal! Third Level introduces half pass at trot and canter, extended paces and the giant leap: flying changes! Christian will demonstrate exercises designed to develop these movements as a continuous training progression, without rushing or forcing the flying change in particular. Once the change is established, the journey toward Grand Prix is relatively continuous until the next big leap from Intermediare I to Intermediare II.
