The move from Training & 1st levels to 2nd & 3rd levels is one of those known major steps in the journey up the levels of Dressage. It can be where the horse/rider pair runs into a wall that stops them or significantly delays their progression in training and showing. It is a big jump in expectations and many new movements are added to the test patterns: shoulder-in, travers, renvers, rein back, turn on the haunches, simple changes, & medium gaits. Then 3rd level adds in half-pass, the flying change, and extended gaits.

In this Workshop, riders will first be coached on how to do a proper warm-up based on the level of test they are riding. Auditor questions & comments are encouraged. The rider will then perform the new dressage test of their choice, judged by a panel of USDF "L" Graduates. Auditors are also asked to practice judge. Discussion will follow.

The format of this Workshop is designed to help riders prepare for a successful competition ride, & to help both riders & auditors understand the preparations needed, & the process of judging the new 2011 USDF Dressage test patterns.
