Wim Ernes is a 5* FEI Olympic level dressage judge popular around the world. He was previously the Dutch Dressage Team's Head coach for the 1996 Olympics in Atlanta where Holland won Team Silver and Anky won the individual Gold medal. After that he concentrated on his career as an International FEI Judge. He received his "O" Judges stature in 2007 and was a member of the prestigious Judging Team at the 2012 Olympic Games in London. Wim is also an expert on breeding, and is the President of the Stallion Selection Committee for the KWPN. The Netherlands Federation announced that Wim Ernes has been signed on as Head Coach of the Dutch Dressage Team again now through the 2016 Olympics in Rio de Janeiro. Wim is a regular headline speaker at the Global Dressage Forum each year. This seminar with Wim Ernes promises to give us top-of-the-World-class advice from the perspective of a Judge, a Trainer, an Instructor, and a Breeder. You won't want to miss it!


